

- Consistent exposure of 80%-86% to the top 3 “new economy” sectors (Tech, Consumer Discretionary and Healthcare)
- Ratio of the aggregate market cap of NDX vs. S&P 500 (SPX) has grown to 54%
- The 8 largest U.S. companies (Nvidia, Apple, Alphabet, Microsoft, Amazon, Meta Platforms, Broadcom and Tesla) are included in NDX

Fundamentally Driven Outperformance

NDX and SPX have had very similar volatility over the last 19 years

Firms in NDX spend 25% more on R&D, on average, compared to SPX

NDX demonstrated much higher (>2x) fundamental growth compared to SPX




Fundamental CAGR of NDX and SPX from 2003 to 2024

Metric	NDX	SPX
Earnings	19.3%	9.0%
Revenues	11.6%	5.2%
Dividends	22.2%	7.5%

Impressive + Consistent Outperformance

- Over the past 18 years, the **total return of NDX was 2.4 times that of SPX** (1,342% vs. 560%), or 45% higher on an annualized basis (16.0% vs. 11.1% CAGR)
- NDX has outperformed SPX in 14 of the past 18 full calendar years**, including by nearly 30% in 2023, 2020 and 2009.
- QQQ, which tracks the NDX, ranked in the 99th percentile among all funds in Morningstar’s Large Growth category for tax-adjusted returns over the past 15 years.
