NASDAQ OMX Green Economy Sector IndexSM Family Methodology

Index Description

The NASDAQ OMX Green Economy Sector Index Family tracks the performance of the companies that are included in the NASDAQ OMX Green Economy Index by various sectors and sub-sectors.

Index Calculation

The NASDAQ OMX Green Economy Sector Indexes are market capitalization weighted indexes. The value of each Index equals the aggregate value of the Index share weights, also known as the Index Shares, of each of the Index Securities multiplied by each such security's Last Sale Price¹ and spot rate, and divided by the divisor of the Index. The divisor serves the purpose of scaling such aggregate value to a lower order of magnitude which is more desirable for reporting purposes. The Indexes began at a base value of 1000.00.

The formula for index value is as follows:

Aggregate Adjusted Market Value/Divisor

The formula for the divisor is as follows:

(Market Value after Adjustments/Market Value before Adjustments) X Divisor before Adjustments

Two versions of each of the Sector Indexes are calculated – a price return index and a total return index. The price return index is ordinarily calculated without regard to cash dividends on Index Securities. The total return index reinvests cash dividends on the exdate. Both Indexes reinvest extraordinary cash distributions.

The Index is calculated in United States Dollars (USD) five (5) days a week, Monday through Friday starting by the earliest time zone Asia/Tokyo and close by the latest time zone America/New York. Additionally, if trading in an Index Security is halted on its primary listing market, the last traded price for that security is used for all index computations until trading resumes. SIX Telekurs Intraday Spot Rates are applied to the real time Index Calculations during the trading day. The WM/Reuters Closing Spot Rates (4 P.M. UK fix) is used in the calculation of the closing Index Values.

Eligibility

¹ For purposes of this document, Last Sale Price refers to the last regular way trade reported on such security's Index Market. The Index Market is the listing market for which prices are received and used by Nasdaq in the Index calculation and generally will represent the most liquid trading market of the Index Security. If a security does not trade on its Index Market on a given day or the Index Market has not opened for trading, the most recent last sale price from the Index Market (adjusted for corporate actions, if any) is used. For securities where Nasdaq is Index Market, the Last Sale Price may be the Nasdaq Official Closing Price (NOCP) when NASDAQ is closed.

Index eligibility is limited to specific security types only. The security types eligible for the indexes include common stocks, ordinary shares, depositary receipts (both American and Global), depositary shares, Dutch certificates, shares of beneficial interest or limited partnership interests, stapled securities and tracking stocks.

Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible for inclusion, a security must be included in the NASDAQ OMX Green Economy Index. Each security in the NASDAQ OMX Green Economy Index is included in one of the following primary sectors:

Additional Indexes may be created based on existing sectors which are designed to enhance the liquidity and increase the tradability of the index.

Index Evaluation

The Indexes are evaluated annually in June in conjunction with the annual review of the NASDAQ OMX Green Economy Index. Securities meeting the criteria are included in the Indexes. Security additions and deletions are made effective after the close of trading on the third Friday in June.

Additionally, if at any time during the year other than the Evaluation, an Index Security no longer meets the Eligibility Criteria, or is otherwise determined to have become ineligible for inclusion in the Indexes, the security is removed from its Index and is not replaced. Ordinarily, a security will be removed from the Index at its Last Sale Price. If, however, at the time of its removal the Index Security is halted from trading on its Index Market and an official closing price cannot readily be determined, the Index Security may, in Nasdaq's discretion, be removed at a zero price. The zero price will be applied to the Index Security after the close of the market but prior to the time the official closing value of the Index is disseminated, which is ordinarily 17:16:00 ET.

Index Maintenance

Changes in the price and/or Index Shares driven by corporate events such as stock dividends, stock splits, and certain spin-offs and rights issuances are adjusted on the exdate. A change in the total shares outstanding2 arising from other corporate actions including, secondary offerings, stock repurchases, conversions, and acquisitions is ordinarily made to the Index on the evening prior to the effective date of such corporate action or as soon as practicable thereafter.

A special cash dividend announced by the listing exchange, will result in an adjustment to the Last Sale Price of an Index Security prior to market open on the ex-date for the special amount distributed. A special dividend may also be referred to as extra, extraordinary, non-recurring, one-time, unusual, etc.

Ordinarily, whenever there is a change in Index Shares, a change in an Index Security or a change to the price of an Index Security due to spin-offs, rights issuances or special cash dividends as mentioned above, the divisor is adjusted to ensure that there is no discontinuity in the value of the Index which might otherwise be caused by any such change. All changes are made after market close and are reflected in the Index the following morning.

Nasdaq may, from time to time, exercise reasonable discretion as it deems appropriate in order to ensure Index integrity.
